

## Live Oak Classical School Dress Code

2015-2016

- Please note there are a few changes to our School Dress Code for the '15-'16 school year. **Please read through the dress code thoroughly so you do not miss any of the changes that pertain to your student.** Any changes that have been made are highlighted in yellow in each section of the dress code document.
- To Order Uniforms: Log on to landsend.com and click on School Uniforms  
Enter our school code: 900132127
- Shopping with our school code ensures you are purchasing the approved LOCS uniform pieces and gives you access to our school logo that is required on all school uniform shirts/sweaters/sweatshirts. Lands' End donates a percentage of all of the sales made using our school code back to Live Oak. **Last year, we received over \$3,000 as a donation back to the school for school uniform items purchased under our school code.**
- The school logo may be put on any additional Lands' End items you wish (such as sweatshirts, fleece jackets, etc.), but you will have to call your order in to Lands' End to have our logo put on any item not listed under our school code.
- Lands' End has excellent customer service – if you are unsatisfied in any way with a uniform piece you have purchased (sizing, item isn't holding up well, etc.) you can return it for a full refund (even if it is an item embroidered with our logo). **You may return Lands' End items to our local Sears store or you may ship your returns directly back to Lands' End.**
- **Please be sure to sign up at Landsend.com to receive email notification of all of the great school uniform sales they run.** We find that shopping “in chunks” can save you money when purchasing uniforms. The best time to buy uniform shirts and any other item requiring our school logo is when **Lands' End runs a free logo sale.** The Free Logo Sale usually runs at least once in the latter part of the summer and will save you the cost of our logo, which is an additional \$8/item. Additionally, Lands' End also runs a 25% off all uniforms sale at least once (and often several times) in the summer – that is the best time to buy uniform bottoms (i.e. shorts, pants, skirts, and jumpers). Additionally, in very late July or early August, Lands' End runs a 40% off of one item sale. This is an excellent time to purchase a more expensive uniform item such as a Rhetoric student's blazer.
- **Please remember we have a Uniform Closet where families sell uniforms their children have outgrown.** You can find good prices on gently used uniforms and shoes in our uniform closet. You may visit the Uniform Closet at the Grammar School during our summer office hours (Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday 9:00 a.m.- 2:00 p.m. – please note our office will be closed the week of June 29 – July 3) or during our **Uniform Closet sales Wednesday, June 24<sup>th</sup> 11:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. and Thursday, July 30<sup>th</sup> 11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.**

**Footwear:**

The intent of our shoe policy is to maintain the tidy look afforded by our school uniforms while also giving some latitude in shopping for appropriate shoes. **Please carefully abide by this policy, and assist the school by not placing us in a position to judge your costly investment as inappropriate.**

- Shoes should be **solid-colored white, black, brown, navy, or gray.**
- Shoes should be closed-toe sneakers, oxfords, loafers/slip-ons (i.e. Sperry's, Tom's or Bob's).
- Soles should be black, white, gray, or brown.
- Embellishments on shoes should be in white, black, or gray/silver only (NO GLITTER, SPARKLES, NEON, RED, BLUE, GREEN, CHARACTERS, ETC.)
- No boots (for exceptions see Friday Free Shoe policy and cold weather policy)
- For P.E./Athletics, students may change into athletic shoes that do not meet the uniform requirements and change back into regular shoes for class.

### **General Uniform Requirements to Note**

- Only Lands' End uniform pieces are allowed – no other brand of uniform clothing is allowed.
- Please be sure to **label all uniform pieces** with student's name.
- Uniforms should be clean and neat upon arrival to school.
- All skirts, skorts, and shorts should be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.
- Modesty shorts are required under all skirts.
- Uniform infractions will be issued with a loss of Falcon Friday privilege for the week.
- Cold weather uniform adjustments: Boots may be worn on days when the temperature is set to freeze (32F); solid black, white, navy, or gray leggings (not "yoga pants" or athletic-type tights) may be worn with non-concert dress; plain black sweatpants may be worn for P.E./Athletics.
- *Backpacks should be simple in design and without cartoon characters*

### **Free Dress Guidelines:**

- Students' personal clothes may be worn but costumes, pajamas, and hats are not allowed.
- Students should refrain from any type of dress or accessory that would be distracting.
- Any shorts, skirts, or skorts should be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.
- Tights and/or leggings may not be worn as pants.

Blazer	Hopsack blazer in navy (with or without logo)
Shirt	Long Sleeve Oxford or No Iron Pinpoint Shirt in French Blue with logo – <b>Shirt must be tucked in</b>
Tie	Rhetoric School tie – to be purchased at Logic and Rhetoric office
Pants	Gray pants
Belt	Black leather belt
Socks	Black socks
Shoes	Black leather shoes
Additional	Undershirts must be white only.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands’ End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands’ End. Top	Long sleeve Oxford Shirt in French Blue with logo - <b>Shirt must be tucked in</b>
Scarf	Rhetoric School scarf - to be purchased from Logic and Rhetoric office
Skirt	<b>Box Pleat skirt</b> in gray with black modesty shorts underneath
Socks	White tights or knee high socks
Shoes	Black leather closed toe, flat shoes – <b>NO HEELS</b>
Additional	Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands’ End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands’ End. Pants	Gray pants
Belt	Black leather belt
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Additional	Undershirts must be white only. **DAILY WEAR UNIFORM OPTIONS – Monday, Wednesday, Thursday**

**Rhetoric Boys – RI – RIII (10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades)**

Shirt	Mesh or Interlock polo shirt in maize, white, black, evergreen, or navy with logo (short or long sleeve) – <b>Shirt must be tucked in</b>
Pants/shorts	Chino pants or shorts (plain front or pleated) in khaki, black, or navy
Belt	<b>Black or brown leather belt required each day with shirt tucked in</b>
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Additional	Undershirts must be white only.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands’ End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands’ End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.  *These purchased in school office; others at Lands’ End

**Rhetoric Girls – RI – RIII (10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades)**

Top	Mesh or Interlock polo shirt (feminine fit style available) in maize, white, black, evergreen, or navy with logo (short or long-sleeve) – <b>Shirt must be tucked in</b>
Skirts	<u>Pleated Ponte Skirt*</u> in khaki or navy (top of the knee style) – <b>New Item!</b>  <u>Box Pleat Skirt*</u> in khaki, black, gray or navy (top of the knee style)  <u>Plaid A-line Skirt*</u> , <u>Solid Pleated Skirt*</u> , or <u>Blend Chino Skort</u> in khaki, black, or navy
Must be no shorter than a credit card height (2”) above the knee.	*must wear black modesty shorts underneath
Pants	Chino pants in khaki, navy, or black
Shorts	Bermuda chino shorts in khaki or navy - Must be no shorter than a credit card height (2”) above the knee
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Leggings	Plain knit leggings in white, black, navy, or gray may be for warmth
Additional	Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands’ End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands’ End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.  *These purchased in school office; others at Lands’ End

**P.E. UNIFORM**

**Girls & Boys - Logic I – Rhetoric III (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades)**

Shirt	Green “Live Oak Athletic Department” t-shirt (purchased at Logic and Rhetoric office or through athletic teams)
Shorts	Black gym shorts
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Athletic shoes - Students may wear athletic shoes that do not meet the uniform requirements and change back into regular uniform shoes for class.

**FALCON FRIDAY DRESS – Friday dress given to students with no uniform infractions during the week**

Shirt	Live Oak crest or falcon, or house t-shirt (can be purchased in the Logic and Rhetoric office), or other official Live Oak t-shirt (not PE or Athletic t-shirt).
Pants/Shorts	Jeans (clean and neat; not too low or baggy, no holes), denim shorts or other denim bottoms, or daily wear uniform shorts/pants. Girls denim shorts, skirts or skorts must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee
Socks	Socks of student’s choice must be worn at all times
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes of student’s choice may be worn
