

**Live Oak Classical School Dress Code**  
**2017-2018**

- Please note there are a few changes to our School Dress Code for the '17-'18 school year. **Please read through the dress code thoroughly so you do not miss any of the changes that pertain to your student.** Any changes that have been made are highlighted in yellow in each section of the dress code document.
- **To Order Uniforms:** Log on to landsend.com and click on School Uniforms  
Enter our school code: 900132127
- Shopping with our school code ensures you are purchasing the approved LOCS uniform pieces and gives you access to our school logo that is required on all school uniform shirts/sweaters/sweatshirts. Lands' End donates a percentage of all of the sales made using our school code back to Live Oak. **Last year, we received over \$3,000 as a donation back to the school for school uniform items purchased under our school code.**
- The school logo may be put on any additional Lands' End items you wish (such as sweatshirts, fleece jackets, etc.), but you will have to call your order in to Lands' End to have our logo put on any item not listed under our school code.
- Lands' End has excellent customer service – if you are unsatisfied in any way with a uniform piece you have purchased (sizing, item isn't holding up well, etc.) you can return it for a full refund (even if it is an item embroidered with our logo). **You may return Lands' End items to our local Sears store or you may ship your returns directly back to Lands' End.**
- **Please be sure to sign up at Landsend.com to receive email notification of all of the great school uniform sales they run.** We find that shopping “in chunks” can save you money when purchasing uniforms. The best time to buy uniform shirts and any other item requiring our school logo is when **Lands' End runs a free logo sale.** The Free Logo Sale usually runs at least once in the latter part of the summer and will save you the cost of our logo, which is an additional \$8/item. Additionally, Lands' End also runs a 25% off all uniforms sale at least once (and often several times) in the summer – that is the best time to buy uniform bottoms (i.e. shorts, pants, skirts, and jumpers). Additionally, in very late July or early August, Lands' End runs a 40% off of one item sale. This is an excellent time to purchase a more expensive uniform item such as a Rhetoric student's blazer.
- Please remember we have a Uniform Closet, located in the Logic/Rhetoric building, where families sell uniforms their children have outgrown. You can find good prices on gently used uniforms and shoes in our Uniform Closet. You may visit the Uniform Closet during our **Uniform Closet sale on Tuesday, August 1 from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**

**Footwear:**

The intent of our shoe policy is to maintain the tidy look afforded by our school uniforms while also giving some latitude in shopping for appropriate shoes. Please carefully abide by this policy, and assist the school by not placing us in a position to judge your costly investment as inappropriate.

- Shoes should be **solid-colored white, black, brown, navy, or gray.**
- Shoes should be closed-toe sneakers, oxfords, loafers/slip-ons (i.e. Sperry's, Tom's or Bob's).
- Soles should be black, white, gray, or brown.
- Embellishments on shoes should be in white, black, or gray/silver only (NO GLITTER, SPARKLES, NEON, RED, BLUE, GREEN, CHARACTERS, ETC).
- No boots (for exceptions see Friday Free Shoe policy & cold weather policy)
- For P.E./Athletics, students may change into athletic shoes that do not meet the uniform requirements and change back into regular shoes for class.

## General Uniform Requirements to Note

- Only Lands' End uniform pieces are allowed – no other brand of uniform clothing is allowed.
- Please be sure to **label all uniform pieces** with student's name.
- Uniforms should be clean and neat upon arrival to school.
- All skirts, skorts, and shorts should be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.
- Modesty shorts are required under all skirts.
- Uniform infractions will be issued with a loss of Falcon Friday privilege for the week.
- Cold weather uniform adjustments: Boots may be worn on days when the temperature is set to freeze (32F); solid black, white, navy, or gray leggings (not "yoga pants" or athletic-type tights) may be worn with non-concert dress; plain black sweatpants may be worn for P.E./Athletics.
- Backpacks should be simple in design and without cartoon characters.
- Students should be clean, well-groomed, and conservatively dressed on campus and at all school functions. Excesses of hair style (including dyeing hair unnatural colors) and attire are out of place. Hair should not be in students' eyes or distracting.

### Free Dress Guidelines:

- Students' personal clothes may be worn but costumes, pajamas, and hats are not allowed.
- Students should refrain from any type of dress or accessory that would be distracting.
- Any shorts, skirts, or skorts should be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.
- No leggings, athletic tights, yoga pants etc. may be worn as pants. Leggings may be worn under dresses or skirts only.

**CONCERT DRESS – For announced special school ceremonies and performances**

**Grammar Boys (K through G6): No Concert dress required for JK students**

Shirt	Oxford or Pinpoint shirt in white with logo (short or long-sleeve). Shirt must be tucked in.
Sweater	Fine Gauge sweater vest in evergreen with logo
Pants	Black pants (plain front or pleated)
Belt	Black leather belt (optional for Kindergarten)
Socks	Black socks
Shoes	Black leather shoes or solid black sneakers (with NO embellishments of any color)
Additional	Undershirts must be white only.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.  *These purchased in school office; others at Lands' End

**Grammar Girls (K through G3): No Concert dress required for JK students**

Top	Short Sleeve Peter Pan Broadcloth Blouse in white with logo.
Jumper	Plaid Jumper with black modesty shorts underneath – Jumper length must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.
Socks	White tights, knee high socks, or bobby socks
Shoes	Black leather Mary Jane shoes
Additional	Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.  *These purchased in school office; others at Lands' End

**Grammar Girls (G4 through G6):**

Top	Short Sleeve Woven Stretch Blouse in white with logo. Shirt must be tucked in.
Skirt	Girls' Plaid Top of the Knee Box Pleat Skirt with black modesty shorts underneath. Skirt length must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee. <b>*Previous Chapel/Concert skirt (Plaid A-line skirt) grandfathered in until 2017-2018 school year.</b>
Socks	White tights or knee high socks only (no bobby socks)
Shoes	Black leather Mary Jane shoes or ballet style black flats. NO HEELS.
Additional	Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.  *These purchased in school office; others at Lands' End

## **CHAPEL DRESS – Worn every Tuesday**

### **Grammar Boys (K through G6): No Chapel Dress required for JK students**

Shirt	Oxford or Pinpoint shirt in white with logo (short or long-sleeve). Shirt must be tucked in
Sweater	Fine Gauge sweater vest in evergreen with logo*- From after Thanksgiving through Easter, sweater vest must be worn for weekly Chapel Dress
Pants/shorts	Black pants or black shorts
Belt	Black leather belt (optional for Kindergarten)
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Additional	<p>Undershirts must be white only.</p> <p>The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.</p> <p>*These purchased in school office; others at Lands' End</p>

Jumper	Plaid Jumper with black modesty shorts underneath - Jumper length must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Leggings	Plain knit leggings in white, black, navy, or gray may be worn for warmth
Additional	<p>Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.</p> <p>The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. Skirt	Girls' Plaid Top of the Knee Box Pleat Skirt with black modesty shorts underneath. Skirt length must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee. <b>*Previous Chapel/Concert skirt (Plaid A-line skirt) grandfathered in until 2017-2018 school year.</b>
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Leggings	Plain knit leggings in white, black, navy, or gray may be worn for warmth
Additional	<p>Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.</p> <p>The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. **DAILY WEAR UNIFORM OPTIONS – Monday, Wednesday, Thursday**

**Grammar Boys (JK through G6)**

Shirt - must be tucked in	Mesh or Interlock polo shirt in maize, white, black, evergreen, or navy with logo (short or long sleeve)
Pants/shorts	Chino pants or shorts (plain front or pleated) in khaki, black, or navy
Belt	Black or brown leather belt required each day with shirt tucked in (belt is optional for JK and K boys)
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Additional	Undershirts must be white only.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.  *These purchased in school office; others at Lands' End

<u>Skirts</u> - Must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.	<u>Pleated Ponte Skirt*</u> in khaki or navy (top of the knee style)  <u>Box Pleat Skirt*</u> in khaki or navy (top of the knee style)  <u>Plaid A-line Skirt*</u> , <u>Solid Pleated Skirt*</u> , or <u>Blend Chino Skort</u> in khaki, black, or navy *must wear black modesty shorts underneath
<u>Pants</u>	Chino pants in khaki, navy, or black
<u>Shorts</u>	Bermuda chino shorts in khaki or navy – Must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee
<u>Dresses</u> – Must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee.	Mesh polo dress in navy or evergreen with logo (short or long-sleeve)  Ruffle Bottom dress in navy or evergreen with logo (short or long-sleeve)  Short sleeve Ponte dress (in black or navy)  Plaid Jumper (JK – G3)  Solid Jumper in khaki or navy with logo (JK – G3)
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate shoe policy page)
Leggings	Plain knit leggings in white, black, navy, or gray may be worn for warmth under dresses and skirts
Additional	Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.  The only sweatshirts or sweaters to be worn in the classroom are the black LOCS hoodie* (pull-over or zip up), the green Live Oak crest sweatshirt*, or any Lands' End sweater, sweatshirt or fleece in solid maize, white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End. Other jackets or sweaters may not be worn in the classroom.  *These purchased in school office; others at Lands' End

**P.E. UNIFORM - Brought to school in a P.E. bag and changed into before P.E. class**

**Scheduled P.E. days:**

- **Grammar 2 through Grammar 3 – Tuesday and Thursday**
- **Grammar 4 through Grammar 6 – Monday, Wednesday, Friday**

**Grammar 2 – Grammar 6 Girls & Boys**

Shirt	Lands' End Short Sleeve Essential T-shirt in evergreen (girls may choose feminine fit) with specified P.E. shirt logo (differs from embroidered logo on uniform polo shirts) <b>or Short Sleeve Active Tee in evergreen with specified P.E. shirt logo – NEW ITEM!</b>
Shorts	Lands' End mesh shorts in black (girl styling differs from boy styling)
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Athletic shoes are required for P.E. - Students may wear athletic shoes that do not meet the uniform requirements and change back into regular uniform shoes for class.
Additional	Some type of P.E. bag is required to bring P.E. clothes to school in (a Live Oak P.E. bag may be purchased in the Grammar Campus office if desired)  Sweatpants in black (no stripes) allowed for warmth (seasonal)

**FALCON FRIDAY DRESS – Friday dress given to students with no uniform infractions during the week**

Shirt	Live Oak crest, falcon, or House t-shirt (purchased in school office), or other official Live Oak t-shirt (not P.E. or Athletic t-shirt).
Pants/Shorts/ Skirts	Shorts or long pants/jeans or skirts/skorts in denim, twill, chino or woven material in the colors of khaki, black, gray or navy (clean and neat; not too low or baggy, no holes), or daily wear uniform shorts/pants.  Girls' shorts, skirts or skorts must be no shorter than a credit card height (2") above the knee
Jeggings	Jeggings with back pockets may be worn by <b>JK through Grammar 3 girls only</b> (Plain knit leggings in white, black, navy, or gray may only be worn <b><u>under</u></b> dresses and skirts for warmth)
Socks	Socks of student's choice must be worn at all times
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes of student's choice may be worn (appropriate for playground)
