Live Oak Classical School Assessment Process



Step four of the Live Oak Classical School's application process is the assessment. *All students require being assessed*. Below outlines and explains the different levels and the process for each.

Junior Kindergarten - First Grade

The Admissions Office will contact the applicant family to schedule a testing time once the application is complete. Students will be scheduled for grade level assessments on January 25, 2025. In Rounds 2 and 3, the Admissions Office will contact the applicant family to schedule onsite testing once the application is complete.

Second Grade - Twelfth Grade

Students applying for fifth grade and above must take the <u>Independent School Entrance Examination</u>. The test can be taken at either Live Oak, online, or at another school that hosts the test. Details about the ISEE (i.e. fee, sample questions, test site locations, etc.) can be found <u>here</u>. Our school's code is 447654. This code is needed for the registration form. The ISEE results must be provided to Live Oak before an application is considered complete and ready for review.

Live Oak Classical School is a closed test site, meaning only applicants applying to Live Oak are allowed to test at our school. If you wish to have your student take the test at Live Oak Classical School, you will need to contact the Admissions Office to get a unique Invitation Code for the date you wish to test. Please register <u>online</u> a minimum of three weeks before the scheduled test date or a late fee will apply. Depending on the number of students pre-registered, there may be availability for the student to "Walk In" the day of the test for an additional fee.
