



## Live Oak Classical School Dress Code 2024-2025

Please read through the Dress Code thoroughly and note any changes from the previous academic year. **Changes for the upcoming school year are highlighted in yellow in each section of the Dress Code document.** If you have a question regarding any dress code or uniform requirement, please contact the appropriate administrator.

Shopping with our school code ensures that you purchase approved LOCS uniform pieces and gives you access to our school logo that is required on uniform tops. The school logo with acorn may be added to any additional Lands' End items you wish, but you will have to call your order in to Lands' End to have the logo put on any item not listed under our school code. Lands' End has excellent customer service, and items can be returned for a full refund (even if it is an item embroidered with our logo).

## GENERAL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- Only Lands' End uniform pieces are allowed – no other brand is allowed.
- Label all uniform pieces with the student's name.
- Uniforms should be clean and neat upon arrival at school.
- Shorts (girls and boys), skirts, dresses and skorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh.
- Modesty shorts are required under all skirts and dresses.
- Uniform infractions will be issued with a loss of Falcon Friday privilege for the week, and the student will be given alternate clothing to change into from the Uniform Closet. If the alternate clothing items are not returned clean to the school within one (1) week, the family will be billed \$5 per item.
- Cold weather uniform adjustments: Girls may wear solid black, white, navy, or gray leggings or tights under skirts and dresses with non-Concert Dress for warmth. Girls and boys may wear Lands' End School Uniform Active Track Pants in black, any sweatpants in solid black (no stripes), or any athletic tights in solid black under athletic shorts for P.E. for warmth.
- Backpacks should be simple in design and without cartoon characters.
- Students are required to dress appropriately and modestly according to the Uniform Policy for school and all school-related activities. This applies to the time students arrive at school until they are off school property at the end of the day, and to the attendance at any Live Oak event. Students should be clean, well-groomed, and conservatively dressed on campus and at all school functions. During the school day, students are required to wear the Live Oak uniform, unless otherwise directed by administration.
- Hair for girls and boys must be natural colors only (black, brown, brunette, blonde, natural red). Hairstyles that are distracting or markedly unusual will not be allowed. Hairstyles for boys that include ponytails, buns, or pinned up styles are not allowed. Boys' hair, regardless of style preference, must not touch the eyebrows in the front, be lower than the bottom of the ear on the sides, or collar in the back (t-shirt collar will be the reference point). Boys must be clean-shaven.
- Grammar students are not allowed to wear makeup. Boys will not wear makeup, fingernail polish, earrings, or body piercings. Girls will not wear body piercing jewelry of any type other than earrings. Visible tattoos or other markings are prohibited.

## **Footwear:**

The intent of our shoe policy is to maintain the tidy look afforded by our school uniforms while also giving some latitude in shopping for appropriate shoes.

- Daily Wear shoes should be solid-colored white, black, brown, navy, or gray. Daily Wear shoes should be closed-toe sneakers, oxfords or loafers/slip-ons (i.e. Sperry's, Tom's or Bob's). Embellishments should be minimal (no glitter, sparkles, characters, lights, etc.)
- Students may only wear boots with long pants or on cold weather days. Boots must have square heels, and be no higher than the knee.
- No heels higher than 1"
- No wheeled shoes or sandals
- No Crocs for Grammar School. No Crocs or clogs/mules for Logic and Rhetoric School except on Falcon Friday
- For P.E., students may change into athletic shoes (these do not need to meet the uniform requirements) and change back into Daily Wear shoes or boots for class

## **Free Dress Guidelines:**

- Costumes, pajamas, and hats are prohibited
- Students should refrain from any type of dress or accessory that would be distracting
- Shorts (girls and boys), skirts, dresses and skorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Joggers, sweatpants, athletic/warm-up pants and athletic shorts (must be no shorter than mid-thigh) are allowed
- Leggings and yoga pants may be worn as pants only if shirt reaches mid-thigh
- Athletic tights may be worn under athletic shorts (girls and boys)
- No heels higher than 1"
- No strapless tops or tops with spaghetti straps, halter ties or off-the shoulder styles
- No tank tops (girls and boys)
- No rips or holes in shorts, pants or jeans
- If a student has PE on a free dress day, they must bring shoes to comply with PE dress.

### GRAMMAR CONCERT DRESS

For announced special school ceremonies and performances

(No Concert Dress required for Junior Kindergarten students)

#### Boys -- Kindergarten through Grammar 6

Shirt *tucked in*	Oxford or Pinpoint shirt in white with logo (short or long-sleeve)
Tie	Pre-tied plaid bowtie (Kindergarten-Grammar 3); Pre-tied plaid necktie (Grammar 4-6). These items must be purchased through the Spirit Shop.
Pants	Chino pants in black (plain front or pleated) or Iron Knee Active Chino pants in black
Belt	Black leather belt (optional for Kindergarten)
Socks	Black socks
Shoes	Solid black leather dress shoes with dark soles or solid black sneakers (with NO embellishments of any color)
Additional	Please make sure clothing items are clean and not wrinkled. Undershirts must be white only.

#### Girls -- Kindergarten through Grammar 3

Shirt	Short Sleeve Peter Pan Broadcloth Blouse or Short/Long Sleeve Button Front Peter Pan Button Collar Knit Shirt in white with optional logo
Jumper	Plaid Jumper*
Socks	White knee high socks (must be purchased through the online Spirit Shop)
Shoes	Black leather Mary Jane shoes. No heels.
Additional	Please make sure clothing items are clean and not wrinkled. Any undergarments worn under Concert blouse must be white or skin tone. Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.

#### Girls - Grammar 4 through Grammar 6

Shirt *tucked in*	Oxford dress shirt (short or long-sleeve) Short Sleeve No Gape Stretch Shirt in white with logo grandfathered in
Skirt	Girls' Plaid Top of Knee Box Pleat Skirt*
Socks	White knee high socks (must be purchased through the Spirit Shop)
Shoes	Black leather Mary Jane shoes or ballet-style black flats. No heels.
Additional	Please make sure clothing items are clean and not wrinkled. Any undergarments worn under Concert blouse must be white or skin tone. Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors.

*\*must be no shorter than mid-thigh; with black modesty shorts underneath.*

## GRAMMAR CHAPEL DRESS

### Boys -- Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 6

Shirt *tucked in*	Oxford or Pinpoint shirt in white with logo (short or long-sleeve)
Pants/Shorts	Chino pants in black (plain front or pleated), or Iron Knee Active Chino pants in black, or black shorts (no shorter than mid-thigh)
Belt	Black leather belt (optional for Kindergarten)
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate Footwear section)
Additional	Undershirts must be white only. On chapel days students may wear other "Approved Classroom Outerwear" (see daily wear guidelines) except during the chapel service where only Lands' End sweaters and cardigans are permitted.

### Girls -- Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 3

Shirt	Short Sleeve Peter Pan Broadcloth Blouse or Short/Long Sleeve Button Front Peter Pan Button Collar Knit Shirt in white with optional logo
Jumper	Plaid Jumper*
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate Footwear section). No heels.
Additional	Any undergarments worn under Chapel blouse must be white or skin tone. Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors. On chapel days students may wear other "Approved Classroom Outerwear" (see daily wear guidelines) except during the chapel service where only Lands' End sweaters and cardigans are permitted.

### Grammar Girls - Grammar 4 through Grammar 6

Shirt *tucked in*	Oxford dress shirt (short or long-sleeve) Short Sleeve No Gape Stretch Shirt in white with logo grandfathered in
Skirt	Girls' Plaid Top of Knee Box Pleat Skirt*
Socks	Socks (solid black or solid white) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate Footwear section). No heels.
Additional	Any undergarments worn under Chapel blouse must be white or skin tone. Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors. On chapel days students may wear other "Approved Classroom Outerwear" (see daily wear guidelines) except during the chapel service where only Lands' End sweaters and cardigans are permitted.

*\*must be no shorter than mid-thigh; with black modesty shorts underneath. Leggings or tights in white, black, navy, or gray may be worn under skirts for warmth.*

Shirt *tucked in*	Mesh or Interlock polo shirt in white, black, evergreen, or navy with logo (short or long sleeve) or Rapid Dry Active polo shirt in white, evergreen, navy or black with logo.
Pants/Shorts	Chino pants or shorts, plain front or pleated, in khaki, black, or navy or Active Chino shorts in khaki, navy or black (no shorter than mid-thigh); Iron Knee Active Chino pants in khaki, navy or black
Belt	Black or brown leather belt required with shirt tucked in (JK, K optional)
Socks	Socks (solid black, solid white or solid gray) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate Footwear section)
Approved Classroom Outerwear	Only items sold in the Spirit Shop under the "Approved Classroom Outerwear" section or the Lands' End website may be worn on campus with the exception of winter coats and rain jackets for outdoor use.
Additional	Undershirts must be white only

### Girls – Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 6

Shirt *tucked in*	Mesh or Interlock polo shirt (feminine fit style available) in white, black, evergreen, or navy w/ logo (short or long sleeve); Rapid Dry Active polo shirt in white, evergreen, navy or black w/ logo; or Peter Pan collar (plain front) polo in white w/ logo (short or long sleeve)
Bottoms	<u>Skirts</u> : Pleated Ponte Skirt* in khaki, black or navy (top of the knee style); Box Pleat Skirt* in khaki or navy (top of the knee style); Solid Pleated Skirt* in khaki, black or navy; or Plaid A-line Skirt* <u>Skorts</u> : Blend Chino Skort* in khaki, black, or navy; Active Skort* in black or navy; or Active Chino Skort in navy or khaki <u>Pants/Shorts</u> : Chino pants in khaki, navy, or black; Bermuda chino shorts* in khaki or navy; or Active chino shorts* in khaki, navy or black
Belt	Black or brown leather belt must be worn if bottoms have belt loops
Dresses & Jumpers	Mesh polo dress* in navy or evergreen with logo or Ruffle Bottom dress* in navy or evergreen with logo (short or long-sleeve); Short sleeve Ponte dress* in black or navy with logo Plaid or Solid Jumper* in khaki or navy with logo (JK through G3 only)
Socks	Socks (solid black, solid white or solid gray) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate Footwear section). No heels.
Approved Classroom Outerwear	Only items sold in the Spirit Shop under the "Approved Classroom Outerwear" section or the Lands' End website may be worn on campus with the exception of winter coats and rain jackets for outdoor use.
Additional	Any undergarments worn under white must be white or skin tone Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors

## GRAMMAR P.E. UNIFORM

Grammar 2-6 only; No P.E. uniforms for Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 1

### Boys & Girls – Grammar 2 through Grammar 6

Shirt	Lands' End Short Sleeve Essential T-shirt in evergreen (girls may choose feminine fit) with specified P.E. shirt logo (differs from embroidered logo on uniform polo shirts) or Short Sleeve Active Tee in evergreen with specified P.E. shirt logo
Shorts	<b>Black "LO" shorts (purchased through the Spirit Shop)</b> Lands' End mesh shorts in black (girl styling differs from boy styling) will be grandfathered in for the 2024 - 2025 school year.
Socks	Socks (solid black, solid white or solid gray) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Athletic shoes are required for P.E. - students may wear athletic shoes that do not meet the uniform requirements and change back into regular uniform shoes for class.  Grammar 4-6 students need athletic shoes for P.E., volleyball, and basketball practices. Shoes must have non-marking soles and must be only worn inside on the gym courts (not outside). Shoes will be kept at school in a drawstring bag such as the one sold in the Spirit Shop. Students who don't have their athletic shoes will not be able to participate in P.E. or practices.
Additional	Some type of P.E. bag is required to bring P.E. clothes to school in  Girls and boys may wear Lands' End School Uniform Active Track Pants in black; any sweatpants in solid black or any athletic tights in solid black under P.E. shorts for warmth

### Schedule for P.E. Uniform Attire:

Grammar 2-3: Tuesday & Thursday - Arrive at school and wear P.E. uniform all day.

#### Grammar 4 - 6:

- Monday - Arrive at school in chapel uniform; bring P.E. uniform in a drawstring bag.
- Wednesday - Arrive at school in P.E. uniform and wear all day.
- Friday - Arrive at school in P.E. uniform shorts and Falcon Friday shirt (options include the P.E. uniform shirt) and wear all day.

## GRAMMAR FALCON FRIDAY DRESS

Falcon Friday dress granted to students with no uniform infractions during the week.

### Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 3

Shirt	Live Oak t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie (including Lands' End P.E. shirt)
Bottoms	Shorts*, long pants/jeans, or skirts*/skorts* in denim, twill, chino or woven material in the colors of khaki, black, gray or navy (clean and neat, not too low or baggy, no holes); or daily wear uniform shorts*, pants, skirts*, or dresses*  No leggings, yoga pants, tights, active wear, etc. may be worn as pants. No joggers, sweatpants, athletic/warm-up pants or athletic shorts. No rips or holes in shorts, pants or jeans. Jeggings with back pockets may be worn by Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 3 girls ONLY.
Socks	Socks of student's choice -- must be worn at all times
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes or boots of student's choice may be worn (appropriate for playground). No heels. No sandals or Crocs.
Additional	Boys or Girls: Any undershirt that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or black  Girls: Any undergarment that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or personal skin tone

### Grammar 4 through Grammar 6

Shirt	Live Oak t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie (including Lands' End P.E. t-shirt)
Bottoms	P.E. shorts or pants (see P.E. uniform guidelines)
Socks	Socks of student's choice -- must be worn at all times
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes or boots of student's choice may be worn (appropriate for playground). No heels. No sandals or Crocs. <b>Grammar 4-6 students must bring athletic shoes on Falcon Friday.</b>
Additional	Any undershirt that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or black. Any girl's undergarment that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or skin tone.

*\*must be no shorter than mid-thigh; girls wearing skirts/shorts/dresses must wear black modesty shorts underneath. Leggings or tights in white, black, navy, or gray may be worn under skirts for warmth.*

Shirt *tucked in*	Long Sleeve Oxford or Long Sleeve No-Iron Pinpoint Shirt in white w/ logo
Tie	Logic School tie (must be purchased through the Spirit Shop)
Pants	Chino pants in black or Iron Knee Active Chino pants in black
Belt	Black leather belt
Socks	Black socks
Shoes	Solid black leather dress shoes with dark soles or solid black dress boots
Additional	Please make sure clothing items are clean and not wrinkled. Undershirts must be white only. Only Lands' End sweaters, sweatshirts or fleece in solid white, black, evergreen, navy or gray with our school logo applied by Lands' End, or items sold in the online Spirit Shop under the "Approved Classroom Outerwear" section may be worn in the classroom for warmth.

#### Girls – Logic 1 through Logic 3 (7<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> grades)

Shirt *tucked in*	Long Sleeve No Iron Pinpoint or Long Sleeve No Gape Stretch Shirt in white w/ logo
Scarf	Logic School scarf (must be purchased through the online Spirit Shop)
Skirt	Top of Knee Box Pleat Skirt* in black
Socks	White knee high socks (must be purchased through the Spirit Shop)
Shoes	Solid black leather closed-toe dress shoes. Shoe heels must be no higher than 2".
Additional	Please make sure clothing items are clean and not wrinkled. Undergarments worn under Concert blouse must be white or skin tone. Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors. Only items sold in the Spirit Shop under the "Approved Classroom Outerwear" section or the Lands' End website may be worn on campus with the exception of winter coats and rain jackets for outdoor use.

Shirt *tucked in*	No Iron Pinpoint or Oxford Shirt in white with logo -- short or long sleeve. <u>NOTE:</u> From after Thanksgiving through Easter, the long sleeve shirt must be worn for Chapel.
Tie	Logic School tie (must be purchased through the Spirit Shop)
Pants/ Shorts	Chino pants in black or Iron Knee Active Chino pants in black or black shorts. <u>NOTE:</u> From after Thanksgiving through Easter, black pants must be worn for Chapel.
Belt	Black leather belt
Socks	Socks (solid black or white) must be worn at all times. <u>NOTE:</u> From after Thanksgiving through Easter, solid black socks must be worn for Chapel.
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes* (please see separate Footwear section)
Additional	Undershirts must be white only.  Only items sold in the Spirit Shop under the “Approved Classroom Outerwear” section or the Lands’ End website may be worn on campus with the exception of winter coats and rain jackets for outdoor use.

Shirt *tucked in*	Mesh or Interlock polo shirt in white, black, evergreen, or navy with logo (short or long-sleeve) or Rapid Dry Active polo shirt in white, evergreen, navy or black with logo
Pants/Shorts	Chino pants or shorts* (plain front or pleated) in khaki, black, or navy; Men’s Active Chino Pants in khaki or navy; or Active chino shorts in khaki, navy or black *Shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
Belt	Black or brown leather belt required each day with shirt tucked in
Socks	Socks (solid black, solid white or solid gray) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (please see separate Footwear section)
Additional	Undershirts must be white only. Only items sold in the Spirit Shop under the “Approved Classroom Outerwear” section or the Lands’ End website may be worn on campus with the exception of winter coats and rain jackets for outdoor use.

Bottoms	<u>Skirts:</u> Pleated Ponte Skirt* in khaki, black or navy (top of the knee style); Box Pleat Skirt* in khaki, black or navy (top of the knee style); Solid Pleated Skirt* in khaki, black, or navy; or Plaid A-line Skirt* <u>Skorts:</u> Blend Chino Skort* in khaki, black, or navy; or Active Chino Skort in navy or khaki <u>Pants/Shorts:</u> Chino pants in khaki, navy, or black; or Women’s Straight Leg Active Chino Pants in khaki or navy; Bermuda chino shorts* in khaki or navy; or Active chino shorts* in khaki, navy or black

Additional	Undergarments worn under white shirts must be white or skin tone. Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors. Only items sold in the Spirit Shop under the “Approved Classroom Outerwear” section or the Lands’ End website may be worn on campus with the exception of winter coats and rain jackets for outdoor use.

## LOGIC ATHLETICS / OFF-SEASON UNIFORM

Shirt	Green "Live Oak Athletics" t-shirt (purchased through the Spirit Shop)
Shorts	Black "LO" shorts (purchased through the online Spirit Shop)
Socks	Socks (solid black, solid white or solid gray) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Athletic shoes are required for Athletics and Off-Season. Students may wear athletic shoes that do not meet the uniform requirements and change back into regular uniform shoes for class.
Additional	Only athletic hoodies and sweatpants sold through the Spirit Shop may be worn as outerwear for Athletics and Off-Season. No other outerwear items will be allowed, even if they are in school colors. Any athletic tights in solid black may be worn under athletic shorts for warmth.

## LOGIC FALCON FRIDAY DRESS

Falcon Friday dress granted to students with no uniform infractions during the week.

Shirt	Live Oak t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie (including Athletic shirts)
Pants/Shorts/ Skirts/Skorts	Shorts* or long pants/jeans or skirts*/skorts* in denim, twill, chino or woven material in the colors of khaki, black, gray or navy (clean and neat, not too low or baggy, no holes); or daily wear uniform shorts*, pants, skirts* or dresses*  No leggings, yoga pants, tights, active wear, etc. may be worn as pants No rips or holes in shorts, pants or jeans Joggers, sweatpants, athletic/warm-up pants are allowed if they have the Live Oak symbol on them. Shorts must be off-season shorts, at least mid-thigh, and the Live Oak symbol must be visible below the shirt.
Socks	Socks of student's choice must be worn at all times
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes or boots of student's choice may be worn. Heels must be less than 2". No sandals.
Additional	Any undershirt that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or black. Any girl's undergarment that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or skin tone.

## RHETORIC FALCON FRIDAY DRESS

Falcon Friday dress granted to students with no uniform infractions during the week.

Shirt	Live Oak t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie (including Athletic shirts)
Pants/Shorts Skirts/Skortts	Shorts* or long pants/jeans or skirts/skortts* in denim, twill, chino or woven material in khaki, black, gray or navy (clean and neat; not too low or baggy, no holes), or daily wear uniform shorts/pants  No leggings, yoga pants, tights, active wear, etc. may be worn as pants No rips or holes in shorts, pants or jeans. Joggers, sweatpants, athletic/warm-up pants are allowed if they have the Live Oak symbol on them. Shorts must be off-season shorts, at least mid-thigh, and the Live Oak symbol must be visible below the shirt.
Socks	Socks of student’s choice must be worn at all times
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes or boots of student’s choice may be worn. Heels must be less than 2”. No sandals.
Additional	Any undershirt that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or black. Any girl’s undergarment that shows under a Falcon Friday shirt should be white or skin tone.
