



Live Oak Classical School Dress Code Grammar School 2025-2026

Please note the few changes to our School Dress Code for the 2025-2026 school year. Please read through the Dress Code thoroughly so you do not miss any of the changes that pertain to your student. **Any changes that have been made are highlighted in yellow in each section of the Dress Code document.** If you have a question regarding any dress code or uniform requirement, please contact the appropriate administrator.

Please note we have a Uniform Closet to purchase gently used uniform pieces. Additionally, there is a Facebook page called "Live Oak Classical Used Uniform Swap Page". "Like" the page and use it to buy, sell and donate uniforms.

Uniform Requirements

- Only Lands' End and Spirit Shop uniform pieces are allowed – no other brand of uniform clothing is allowed unless otherwise stated.
- All shorts, skirts/skorts, and dresses must be no shorter than mid thigh. Skirts and dresses must be worn with black modesty shorts underneath.
- No visible undergarments. All garments worn under white shirts should be of personal skin tone or white.
- All outerwear, sweatshirts, and sweaters must be Lands' End or Spirit Shop items from the approved outerwear section with the exception of winter coats and rain jackets for outdoor wear."
- Girls may wear solid black, white, navy, or gray leggings or tights under skirts and dresses with non-Concert Dress.
- Girls and boys may wear any solid black sweatpants or athletic tights under athletic shorts for PE.
- Label all uniform pieces with the student's name.
- Uniforms should be clean and neat upon arrival at school.
- Girls' hair must be natural colors only (black, brown, brunette, blonde, natural red). Girls will not wear body piercing jewelry of any type or style other than earrings.
- Boys' hair must be natural colors only (black, brown, brunette, blonde, natural red) and length must not touch the eyebrows in the front, be lower than the bottom of the ear on the sides, or t-shirt collar in the back.
- Boys must be clean-shaven and may not wear makeup, fingernail polish, earrings, or body piercings.
- Grammar students are not allowed to wear makeup.
- Visible tattoos or other markings are not allowed.
- Uniform infractions will be issued with a loss of Falcon Friday privilege for the week, and the student will be given alternate clothing to change into from the Uniform Closet. If the alternate clothing items are not returned clean to the school within one (1) week, the family will be billed \$5 per item.

Footwear

- Daily Wear shoes should be closed toed, **solid-colored white, black, brown, navy, or gray**.
- Embellishments on Daily Wear shoes or boots should be minimal (no glitter, sparkles, characters, lights, etc.). Colored branding or details are permitted but must be minimal.
- Students may only wear boots with long pants, leggings, or tights.
- No wheeled shoes, sandals, Crocs, or heels higher than 1”
- For PE, students may change into athletic shoes and change back into Daily Wear shoes/ boots for class.

Free Dress Guidelines

- Students’ personal clothes may be worn but costumes, pajamas, and hats are not allowed
- Students should refrain from any type of dress or accessory that would be distracting
- Shorts, skirts, dresses and skorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Joggers, sweatpants, athletic/warm-up pants are allowed. Athletic shorts are not permitted.
- Leggings and yoga pants may be worn as pants only if shirt reaches mid-thigh
- No heels higher than 1”
- No tank tops, strapless tops or tops with spaghetti straps, halter ties or off-the shoulder styles
- No rips or holes in shorts, pants or jeans
- If a student has PE on a free dress day, they must bring shoes that comply with PE dress code.

Shirt – must be tucked in	White Oxford or Pinpoint shirt with logo (short or long-sleeve)
Tie	K-G3: Pre-tied plaid bowtie (purchased through spirit shop) G4-G6: Pre-tied plaid necktie (purchased through spirit shop)
Pants	Black Chino or Iron Knee Active Chino pants. No shorts
Belt	Black leather belt (optional for Kindergarten)
Socks	Black socks
Shoes	Solid black leather dress shoes with dark soles or solid black sneakers. No embellishments.

Grammar Girls -- Kindergarten through Grammar 3 (no JK)

Shirt	White Peter Pan Broadcloth Blouse or Button Front Peter Pan Button Collar Knit Shirt with optional logo (short or long sleeve)
Jumper	Plaid Jumper
Socks	White knee high socks (purchased through Amazon)
Shoes	Black leather Mary Jane shoes or ballet-style black flats . No heels.
Additional	Any undergarments worn under Concert blouse must be white or personal skin tone Hair accessories must be modest and in school colors

Socks	White knee high socks (purchased through Amazon)

Socks	Solid white, black, or gray socks

Additional	Only Lands’ End sweaters and cardigans may be worn during chapel.

Pants/Shorts	<i>Khaki, navy, or black</i> pants or shorts Plain or pleated chino or Active Chino
Belt	Black or brown leather belt - optional for JK/K
Socks	Solid white, black, or gray socks
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes
Outerwear	Approved Classroom Outerwear

Grammar Girls – Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 6:

Shirt – must be tucked in	<i>White, black, evergreen, or navy</i> polo shirt with logo Mesh, Interlock, knit or Rapid Dry Active options available in short and long sleeve. Feminine fit and Peter Pan collars available.
Bottoms	<i>Khaki, black, or navy</i> skirt, skort, pants or shorts. Skirts: pleated ponte, box pleat, solid pleat, or a-line Skorts: blend chino, active chino, or active skort Shorts: chino, bermuda chino, or active chino Pants: chino or active chino
Belt	Brown or black leather belt required with pants or shorts
Dresses/Jumpers	Black, navy, or evergreen dress with logo Mesh polo or ruffle bottom dress in short or long sleeve or ponte dress in short sleeve Plaid or solid jumper in navy or khaki (JK-G3 only)
Socks	White, black, or gray socks
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes (see Footwear section)
Outerwear	Approved Classroom Outerwear

P.E. UNIFORM (GRAMMAR 4 THROUGH GRAMMAR 6 ONLY)

*(No P.E. uniforms needed for Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 3)

Grammar 4-6: Come to school in daily uniform and bring the PE uniform to school in a drawstring bag to change in and out of on Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays.

Grammar Boys & Girls – Grammar 4 through Grammar 6:

Shirt	Evergreen T-shirt with PE logo Essential, active, and feminine fits available
Shorts/Pants	Black “LO” shorts (purchased through the Spirit Shop) Black active track pants or black sweatpants
Socks	Solid white, black, or grey socks
Shoes	Athletic shoes are required for P.E. Must have non-marking soles and must be only worn inside on the gym courts (not outside).
Additional	Drawstring bag for PE shoes

FALCON FRIDAY DRESS

*Friday dress given to students with no uniform infractions during the week

Junior Kindergarten through Grammar 6

Shirt	Live Oak t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie (including P.E. t-shirt)
Pants/Shorts/ Skirts/Skorts	Denim, twill, chino, or woven pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts, excluding denim shorts. Black LO sweatpants. No rips. No leggings, yoga pants, tights, active wear, or athletic shorts
Socks	Socks of student’s choice
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes or boots of student’s choice may be worn (appropriate for the playground).
