

Live Oak Classical School Dress Code Rhetoric School 2025-2026

Please note the few changes to our School Dress Code for the 2025-2026 school year. Please read through the Dress Code thoroughly so you do not miss any of the changes that pertain to your student. Any changes that have been made are highlighted in yellow in each section of the Dress Code document. Uniform Requirements

- Only Lands' End and Spirit Shop uniform pieces are allowed no other brand of uniform clothing is allowed unless otherwise stated.
- All shorts, skirts/skorts, and dresses must be no shorter than mid thigh. Skirts and dresses must be worn with black modesty shorts underneath.
- No visible undergarments. All garments worn under white shirts should be of personal skin tone or white.
- All outerwear, sweatshirts, and sweaters must be Lands' End or Spirit Shop items from the approved outerwear section. Exceptions may be extended for additional outerwear in times of extreme cold or rain.
- Girls may wear solid black, white, navy, or gray leggings or tights under skirts and dresses with non-Concert Dress.
- Girls and boys may wear any solid black sweatpants or athletic tights under athletic shorts for PE.
- Label all uniform pieces with the student's name.
- Uniforms should be clean and neat upon arrival at school
- Girls' hair must be natural colors only (black, brown, brunette, blonde, natural red).
- Girls will not wear body piercing jewelry of any type or style other than earrings.
- Boys' hair must be natural colors only (black, brown, brunette, blonde, natural red) and length must not touch the eyebrows in the front, be lower than the bottom of the ear on the sides, or t-shirt collar in the back.
- Boys must be clean-shaven and may not wear makeup, fingernail polish, earrings, or body piercings.
- Visible tattoos or other markings are not allowed.
- Uniform infractions will be issued with a loss of Falcon Friday privilege for the week, and the student will be given alternate clothing to change into from the Uniform Closet. If the alternate clothing items are not returned clean to the school within one (1) week, the family will be billed \$5 per item.

Footwear

- Daily Wear shoes should be closed toed, solid-colored white, black, brown, navy, or gray.
- Embellishments on Daily Wear shoes or boots should be minimal (no glitter, sparkles, characters, lights, etc.). Colored branding or details are permitted but must be minimal.
- Students may only wear boots with long pants or on cold weather days.
- No wheeled shoes, sandals, or heels higher than 1"
- For PE, students may change into athletic shoes and change back into Daily Wear shoes/boots for class.
- Athletic shoes are required for Athletics and Off-Season. Students may wear athletic shoes that do not meet the uniform requirements and change back into regular uniform shoes for class.

Free Dress Guidelines

- Students' personal clothes may be worn but costumes, pajamas, and hats are not allowed
- Students should refrain from any type of dress or accessory that would be distracting
- Shorts, skirts, dresses and skorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Joggers, sweatpants, athletic/warm-up pants are allowed. Athletic shorts are not permitted.
- Leggings and yoga pants may be worn as pants only if shirt reaches mid-thigh
- No heels higher than 1"
- No tank tops, strapless tops or tops with spaghetti straps, halter ties or off-the shoulder styles
- No rips or holes in shorts, pants or jeans
- If a student has PE on a free dress day, they must bring shoes that comply with PE dress code.

Shirt – must be tucked in	White Oxford or Pinpoint shirt with logo (long-sleeve)
Tie	Rhetoric School tie (purchased through spirit shop)
Pants	Gray Chino or Iron Knee Active Chino pants.
Belt	Black leather belt
Socks	Black socks
Shoes	Solid black leather dress shoes with dark soles or solid black dress boots

Rhetoric Girls – Rhetoric 1 through Rhetoric 3 (10th through 12th grades):

Blazer	Navy Blazer with or without logo
Shirt – must be tucked in	White Oxford shirt with logo (long-sleeve) Pinpoint and no-gape options

Skirt	Gray Box Pleat skirt
Socks	White knee high socks (purchased through Amazon)
Shoes	Solid black leather closed-toe dress shoes.

Shirt – must be tucked in	White, black, evergreen, or navy polo shirt with logo
	Mesh, Interlock, or Rapid Dry Active options available in short and long sleeve
Pants/Shorts	Khaki, navy, or black pants or shorts. Plain or pleated chino or Active Chino
Belt	Black or brown leather belt
Socks	Solid white, black, or gray socks
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes
Shirt – must be tucked in	White, black, evergreen, or navy polo shirt with logo
	Mesh, Interlock, or Rapid Dry Active options available in short and long sleeve

Rhetoric Girls – Rhetoric 1 through Rhetoric 3 (10th through 12th grades):

Shirt – must be tucked in	White, black, evergreen, or navy polo shirt with logo. Mesh, Interlock, knit or Rapid Dry Active options available in short and long sleeve. Feminine fit available.
Bottoms	Khaki, black, or navy skirt, skort, pants or shorts. Skirts: pleated ponte, box pleat, solid pleat, or a-line Skorts: blend chino, active chino, or active skort Shorts: chino, bermuda chino, or active chino Pants: chino or active chino
Belt	Brown or black leather belt required with pants or shorts
Dresses	Black or Navy ponte dress with logo (short sleeve)
Socks	Solid white, black, or gray socks
Shoes	Daily Wear shoes

ATHLETICS or OFF-SEASON UNIFORM

Girls & Boys – Rhetoric 1 through Rhetoric 3 (7th through 12th grades)

Shirt	Green "Live Oak Athletics" t-shirt (purchased through spirit shop)
Shorts	Black "LO" shorts (purchased through spirit shop)
Socks	Socks (solid black, solid white or solid gray) must be worn at all times
Shoes	Athletic shoes
Additional	Only athletic hoodies and sweatpants sold through the online Spirit Shop may be worn as outerwear for Athletics and Off-Season. No other outerwear items will be allowed, even if they are in school colors.

FALCON FRIDAY DRESS

^{*}Friday dress- students with no uniform infractions during the week

Shirt	Live Oak t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie (including Athletic shirts)
Pants/Shorts/	Denim, twill, chino, or woven pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts, excluding denim shorts.
Skirts/Skorts	Black LO sweatpants. No rips. No leggings, yoga pants, tights, active wear, or athletic

Socks	Socks of student's choice
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes or boots of student's choice may be worn. No sandals.
Shirt	Live Oak t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie (including Athletic shirts)
